The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 provides a renewed vision for education in India by emphasizing holistic development, experiential learning, environmental consciousness and the integration of sustainability across all levels of education.

The seminar **NEP 2020: "Transforming Education through Climate Consciousness"** seeks to create a multidisciplinary platform for educators, school leaders, researchers, policymakers and other stakeholders to critically engage with the role of education in addressing climate change.

It focuses on reimagining transformative education through climate consciousness by exploring curriculum integration, transformative pedagogies, teacher education, Indigenous knowledge systems, green campus initiatives, and the use of digital technologies including AI. 1. All submission must be made in MS-Word format.
2. The abstract should be in 500 words with keywords in italic and manuscript should be within 4500-5000 words (A-4 size paper typed in double spaces).
3. The cover page should bear only title of the paper, name of author, designation, official address with their Email-id & phone number.
4. Times New Roman with font size '12' and '1.5' spacing for the text and should follow for English paper American Psychological Association (APA-7th edition) format for reference and other citation.
5. For Hindi paper Kruti Dev 010 font size 14 and 1.5 spacing for the text and should follow Modern language Association (MLA)
6. Submitted papers must not have been previously published, presented or accepted for publication under review.
7. Certificates will be awarded to all the registered Participants/ presenters.
